## Cardiovascular

**Preferable but only for uninsured, US residents:**

**Antithrombotics:** Xarelto

**Heart Failure:** Entresto 24/26,49/51, 97/103

### **Antihypertensives (Blood Pressure):**

**ACE:** Lisinopril (+/- HCTZ combo pill), benazepril, enalapril, ramipiril

**ARB:** Losartan (+/- HCTZ combo pill)

**CCB:** Amlodipine, diltiazem, verapamil, nifedipine

**Diuretic:** HCTZ, triamterene/HCTZ, furosemide, torsemide, spironolactone (potassium supplements), chlorthalidone

**BB:** Metoprolol (tartrate and succinate), carvedilol, atenolol, propranolol, nadolol

**Other:** Clonidine, guanfacine, hydralazine, minoxidil

**Lipid Lowering (Cholesterol):** Atorvastatin, pravastatin, simvastatin, rosuvastatin, fenofibrate

**Antithrombotics (Blood Thinner):** Warfarin, clopidogrel, aspirin

**Antiarrhythmics:** Amiodarone, flecanide, sotalol

**Other:** Digoxin, cilostazol, nitroglycerin, isosorbide, ranolazine ER

## Asthma/COPD/Allergy

**Preferable but only for uninsured, US residents:**

**SABA:** Proventil HFA

**NOTE: We have Spacers for inhalers – they require a prescription.** We also carry nebulizers. Please write Rx for nebulizer device. Solutions available: Albuterol 0.083%; Albuterol/Ipratropium (Duoneb), ipratropium 0.02%

**SABA (Rescue Inhaler):** generic albuterol (200 puffs)

**ICS+LABA:** Wixela 100/50, generic AirDuo 55/14 or 113/14

**LAMA:** Seebri Breezhaler (Through 10/21)

**LABA:** Arcapta Neohaler (Through 8/21)

**Nasal:** Fluticasone (Flonase) nasal spray

**Oral:** Montelukast, prednisone, diphenhydramine, loratadine, cetirizine, fexofenadine, cyproheptadine

## Diabetes

**Preferable but only for uninsured, US residents:** Januvia, Janumet 50/1000, Janumet 50/1000 XR, Invokana 100mg and 300mg

**Preferable but only for any patient without prescription coverage:** Humulin N, R, or 70/30 10ml vials, Humalog U-100 10ml vials

**Preferable for patients without healthcare coverage at all:** Humalog U-100 pens, Basaglar pens, Humalog 75/25 pens

**Oral:** Metformin, glipizide, glyburide, glimepiride, pioglitazone, Kombiglyze XR 5/1000 (through 4/2023)

**Neuropathy:** Gabapentin, amitriptyline, nortriptyline, cyanocobalamin (B12 tablets), duloxetine

### **Glucometer Kits and Supplies Available:**

Strips per month: #25 (orals only), #50 (on insulin) #100 (sliding scale / adjusting insulin dose) No Rx needed.

## Mental Health

**Preferable but only for uninsured, US residents:**

**Antidepressant:** Prozac

**Antidepressants:** Citalopram, escitalopram, fluoxetine, sertraline, paroxetine, venlafaxine, duloxetine, trazodone, bupropion SR and XL, amitriptyline, nortriptyline, mirtazapine

**Anti-Anxiety:** Buspirone, hydroxyzine (SSRIs as above)

**Antipsychotics:** Risperidone, haloperidol, olanzapine, quetiapine, ziprasidone, aripiprazole

**Mood Stabilizers:** lithium, lamotrigine, topiramate, divalproex sodium

**ADHD:** Atomoxetine, Guanfacine ER

**Substance Use Disorder:** Disulfiram, Naltrexone (oral)

**Sleep:** Melatonin (and see Antidepressants)

<p><b><u>Gastrointestinal/ Urinary</u></b></p> <p><b>GERD:</b> Ranitidine, famotidine, pantoprazole, omeprazole, lansoprazole, calcium carbonate 500mg</p> <p><b>Nausea:</b> Meclizine, promethazine, ondansetron</p> <p><b>Constipation:</b> Polyethylene Glycol 3350, docusate, senna (+/- docusate), lactulose, bisacodyl, Fiber-Lax</p> <p><b>Bowel Prep:</b> Gavilyte-C, Gavilyte-N</p> <p><b>Overactive Bladder:</b> Oxybutynin ER, tolteridone ER 4mg</p> <p><b>Prostate:</b> Tamsulosin, doxazosin, finasteride, tadalafil 5mg</p> <p><b>ED:</b> Sildenafil</p> <p><b>Other:</b> Dicyclomine, metoclopramide</p> <p><b>Ulcerative Colitis:</b> Mesalamine 1000mg suppositories (limited supply – expires 9/21)</p>	<p><b><u>Pain</u></b></p> <p><b>Analgesics:</b> Acetaminophen, ibuprofen, naproxen, meloxicam, diclofenac (oral and 1% gel), celecoxib, nabumetone, lidocaine 4% cream and patch</p> <p><b>Muscle Relaxants:</b> Cyclobenzaprine, tizanidine, methocarbamol, baclofen</p> <p><b>Neuropathic:</b> Gabapentin, amitriptyline, nortriptyline, duloxetine</p> <p><b>Migraine:</b> Sumatriptan, butalbital/APAP/caffeine 50mg/325mg/40g</p> <p><b>Steroids:</b> Prednisone, methylprednisolone</p> <p><b>DMARDS:</b> Hydroxyurea, methotrexate, leflunomide, sulfasalazine, hydroxychloroquine</p> <p><b>Other:</b> Glucosamine sulfate (+/- chondroitin)</p>
<p><b><u>Infectious Disease</u></b></p> <p><b>Antibiotics:</b> Amoxicillin (+/- clav), penicillin VK, azithromycin, TMP/SMX, cephalexin, clindamycin, ciprofloxacin, levofloxacin, metronidazole, mupirocin (topical), clarithromycin, doxycycline, minocycline, nitrofurantoin</p> <p><b>Antitussive (Cough):</b> benzonatate, dextromethorphan/guaifenesin syrup, Mucinex</p> <p><b>Antiviral:</b> Acyclovir, valacyclovir</p> <p><b>Antifungals:</b>  <u>Oral:</u> Fluconazole, terbinafine  <u>Topical:</u> Miconazole (including vaginal 3 or 7 day), clotrimazole (+/- betamethasone), terbinafine, nystatin, ketoconazole (cream or shampoo)</p>	<p><b><u>Hormonal</u></b></p> <p>Medroxyprogesterone, estradiol (oral tablets or 0.01% vaginal cream), letrozole, anastrozole, norethindrone, Junel Fe, Sprintec, tamoxifen</p> <p><b><u>Anti-Epileptics (Anti-Seizure)</u></b>  <u><i>Preferable but only for uninsured, US residents:</i></u>  <i>Tegretol XR</i></p> <p>Divalproex DR or ER, levetiracetam, topiramate, phenytoin, gabapentin, oxcarbazepine, zonisamide, lamotrigine, carbamazepine</p>
<p><b><u>Miscellaneous</u></b></p> <p><b>Thyroid:</b> Levothyroxine, methimazole</p> <p><b>Phosphate Binder:</b> Calcium Acetate</p> <p><b>Alzheimers:</b> Donepezil, memantine</p> <p><b>Dopamine agonists:</b> Carbidopa / levodopa, ropinirole, pramipexole</p> <p><b>Gout:</b> Allopurinol</p> <p><b>Topical Corticosteroids:</b>  Triamcinolone cream or ointment, clobetasol  Hydrocortisone cream  Fluticasone cream, mometasone cream</p> <p><b>Anticholinergic:</b> Benztropine</p>	<p><b><u>Eye Care</u></b></p> <p><b>Glaucoma:</b> Brimonidine 0.2%, dorzolamide/timolol, dorzolamide, latanoprost, timolol 0.5%</p> <p><b>Anti-infective:</b> Ciprofloxacin, ofloxacin 0.3%, gentamicin 0.3%, tobramycin 0.3% (solutions), neomycin/polymyxin B/dex ointment/ suspension (<i>may be used Otic if appropriate</i>)</p> <p><b>Steroid:</b> Prednisolone 1% solution (limited by donation)</p> <p><b>NSAID:</b> Ketorolac 0.5% solution</p> <p><b>Allergies:</b> Ketotifen</p>
